**2010 Oregon Pinot Gris**

**\$12.50**

Aromas of white pear, peach, nectarine and yellow apples are complimented by characters of lemon verbena and other fresh herbs. Honey, apricot and geranium notes on the palate integrate with refreshing acids, crisp Oregonian minerality and a lingering complexity, classic notes of the 2010 vintage. A very food friendly wine that will pair well with a large range of food..

**2009 Grande Cuvee Pinot Noir**

**\$16.00**

The 2009 Grande Cuvee Pinot Noir delivers aromas of macerated cherries, black currant, spices and cigar box. The flavors are fresh and juicy, showing ripe black cherries and cassis, framed by a long spicy aftertaste with a vibrant structure.

**2008 Domaine Danielle Laurent Pinot Noir**

**\$32.00**

The wine displays aromatics of clove and glint that lead to a palate of concentrated dark cherry and blueberry compote. A hint of barrel toast flows seamlessly into the long soft finish. An elegant vineyard selection that has enough structure and concentration to age to perfection.

**2008 Hyland Vineyard Pinot Noir**

**\$35.00**

This is our first Pinot Noir from the Hyland Vineyard. Aromas of rose petals, Asian spice and dark berry fruit are subtly complimented by lavender and wet stone. The wine has clean, elegant flavors of blackberries, blueberries and a hint of spice and minerality. **Wine Spectator 93 points, Robert Parker 91 points**

**2007 Vista Hills Vineyard Pinot Noir**

**\$24.50**

This is our third release from the Vista Hills Vineyard. This Pinot Noir displays characteristics common to wines made from the Dundee Hills, The wine is rich with bright red and black fruits. Complex earthy notes, and subtle hints of exotic spices, dried mushroom and tobacco. It demonstrates a robust body, while possessing the texture of fine satin in the mouth for a never-ending finish.

**2007 Wooldridge Creek Zinfandel**

**\$16.00**

The 2007 Zinfandel has expressive fruit aromas of blueberry, blackberry and black cherry lightly highlighted with vanilla and cocoa bean. Spice characters of black pepper, clove and a touch of smoke lead to a long finish on the palate characterized by tannins that seamlessly integrate with the acids and fruit making it a complex yet approachable wine.

**2007 Wooldridge Creek Merlot**

**\$16.00**

The 2007 Merlot is rich with fruit characters of black plum, black cherry, and blueberry. Notes of dried herb, licorice, cocoa and exotic cooking spices immerse themselves elegantly with the fruit and hints of violet in the beautiful, soft and lingering finish.

**2005 Klipsun Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon**

**\$24.50**

A bright wine offering aromas of dust, ripe red cherry, dried plum, vanilla and baking spices. By mouth there are bright red fruits, delineated with a dynamic dried cranberry edge, surrounded by spice, celery seed and toasted herb over moderate tannins that trail into a warm, persistent finish.

**2008 Del Rio Vineyard Syrah**

**\$24.50**

In the nose black cherry, tones of licorice, all spice, and plums are accompanied by inviting aromas of vanilla. The mouth is equally appealing with really dark fruit, well integrated tannins, mineral and slight mushroom tones. The tannins are broad and soft and linger for a long time.



### 2008 1789 Chehalem Mountains Pinot Noir

**\$32.00**

Exuding dark and lush red color, the 2008 lends rich aromas of fresh cherry and black current from the glass, followed by hints of violets and chocolate. The palate exudes intense red fruit and spices with generous concentration and lovely finesse. The elegant structure is deep, round and polished only to be supported by well integrated, fine-grained tannins. Beautifully balanced, it has a lengthy finish with notes of blackberry and spicy toffee. **Robert Parker 91 points**



### 2008 Eminent Domaine Willakia Vineyard Pinot Noir

**\$20.00**

A mature, Oregon style Pinot Noir with intense dark fruits and earthy undertones. With an alcohol content of 14.9%, this wine is surprisingly soft. Primarily harvested from a pommard clone with a hint of 113, this wine can stand up to red meats and wild game.



### 2007 Monk's Gate Pinot Noir

**\$24.00**

Beautiful deep garnet color. Nose shows all spectrums of little berries, from strawberries to raspberries, evolving luscious red cherries. The floral overlay of rose petals brings the wine subtle complexity. Great freshness of fruit when you take your first sip, evolving toward round, soft tannins.

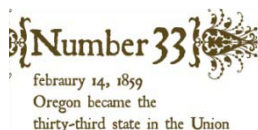

With aromas of ripe strawberries and fresh cut rose petals this 2009 Pinot Noir displays a traditional, yet, energizing nose. The front palate leads with a core of bright cherry preserves followed by hints of red plums. The balanced acidity and soft tannins round out the finish, showcasing a complex yet easily approachable wine.

### 2010 Number 33 Willamette Valley Pinot Gris

**\$7.33**

Aromas of green apple, lemongrass, grapefruit, and pear. True to its Alsatian style, the wine has great balance, weight and substance throughout the palate with appealing acidity and vibrancy displayed in its long finish. Flavors of spiced pear, passion fruit and lemon linger on your palate!

**2009 Number 33 Willamette Valley Riesling**

**\$8.33**

From Hyland Vineyard, this hand crafted single vineyard Riesling exudes elegance and complexity. An exceptional nose opens with passion fruit, citrus, banana and fusel notes. The front palate leads with a core of bright acidity, followed with hints of marmalade, nutmeg and pear. The acidity is balanced with a supple sweetness giving this 2009 Riesling soft body with a crisp finish.
